- i) Every field is mandatory unless specified.
- ii) Wherever (Place X) is indicated, mark X in the box applicable.
- iii) Write the name and Accreditation Number of the Accredited Hardware Institute at Item No. 10 and 11.
- iv) All 10+2 non science students have to qualify 'Bridge Course' examination mandatory.
- v) Item No. 1 to 16 are to be filled in by the applicant while Item No. A and B below 16 are to be filled in by the authorized person of the Accredited Hardware Institute, which is mandatory.
- vi) **ELIGIBILITY:** Given in concerned prospectus.
- vii) **LEVEL:** At any point of time, registration can be only for one level.
- viii) **ADDRESS CHANGE:** Inform immediately quoting Registration Number.
- ix) **REGISTRATION FEE:** Rs. 300/- for each Level ('CHM-O'/ 'CHM-A' Level). Payment should not be clubbed with requests for other documents, like, Prospectus, Syllabus etc. All remittances shall be only by crossed BANK DRAFT, drawn in favour of "Director, DOEACC Centre", payable at Respective DOEACC Regional Centres. Demand Draft, whose validity period is expiring shortly, should not be sent with the registration form. Write your name & address on the reverse side of the BANK DRAFT.
- x) Attach attested photocopy (ies) of certificates of educational/ DOEACC qualifications (NOT of mark sheets).
- xi) Candidates undergoing 'A' Level accredited course during the pendency of graduation or Govt. recognized Polytechnic Engineering Diploma after 10+2 should send proof of the same from the respective institute/ college/ polytechnic.
- xii) Proof of equivalence in terms of Indian Universities should be sent in case the registration is sought based on foreign qualifications.
- xiii) If candidate registered at one level, he/ she shall be allowed to take the examination at the level at which he/ she is subsequently registered only and shall not be allowed to complete the registration at the original level in case of failure in any of the modules/ papers at the original level of examination.
- xiv) Candidates denied registration should not refer to the attested photocopies of certificates of educational/ DOEACC qualification or other documents sent with the earlier registration form, while seeking registration again, with the submission of a fresh registration form, which should be complete in all respects, including all relevant enclosures.
- xv) Registration Forms complete in all respects, received after the last date fixed for receipt of such forms, for a particular examination, will not be considered for that examination, though Registration is open throughout the year.
- xvi) In this form Polytech. Engg. Diploma means Polytechnic Engineering Diploma.
